### Criteria:

▼ must be graduating high school in 2012 and entering college in fall, 2012.

##### b. basic criteria information:

- copy of final grade report showing a minimum of a C average or equivalent.

2.) Please respond to (a.) and one (1) of the other three (3) questions below (2 total). The responses to your two (2) questions should be typed on a single sheet of paper (1" margins, 12 point font, double-spaced) and should **NOT** include your name or other identifying information.

*Assume that the selection committee does not know you and is not familiar with your GLYS or GSA participation.*

**a. Describe how you, as a gay, lesbian, bi, trans or questioning youth, have benefitted from participating in GLYS and/or your school's Gay Straight Alliance.**

b. Describe the challenges you anticipate facing in completing your [postsecondary] education.

c. As an adult, how do you see yourself contributing to the GLBT community in Buffalo or where you may be living?

d. How important would receiving this scholarship be to your education?
